## FOUR-YEAR UNDERGRADUATE COURSE UNDER NEP(FYUGP):(B.A. &B. COM)

The undergraduate degree (UG) program in the **"Four Year Under Graduate Programme"(FYUGP)** is a Choice Based Credit System under the Semester Scheme. According to the guidelines, the four-year undergraduate program should provide a system of several exit choices where the candidate has the option to exit after TWO, FOUR, and SIX semesters of the program (at the end of each academic year After one year. Students will obtain a certificate, two years, a diploma, and three years, a bachelor's degree, should they decide to drop out. Bachelor with Research Distinction will be awarded to those who finish all four years. Two consecutive (one odd and one even) semesters will make up an academic year. A UG course shall be of eight semesters covering four Calendar Years (Academic Sessions – July to June).

### **Duration of the course:**

- i. Odd Semesters (First, Third, Fifth, and Seventh) shall be July –December
- ii. Even Semesters (Second, Fourth, Sixth, and Eight) shall be from January June.

Each applicant must apply for admission throughout four separate academic semesters, beginning with the first one. It will not be permitted for students to be admitted in the third or fourth academic season if they do not enroll in the second academic session. A student will also not be able to apply for admission in the fourth academic session if they do not enroll in the third academic session. The program allows students to choose their courses horizontally. By five years, they can pursue a three-year or six-semester program, and by seven years, a four-year or eight-semester program. Students can retake the course within three years.



## **ELIGIBILITY FOR FYUGP**

Senior Secondary School Leaving Certificate or Higher Secondary (Class 12) Certificate obtained after successful completion of Grade 12 or equivalent stage of education.

- ✤ Admission test conducted by the college is necessary.
- 1st year: The entry requirement for 1st year FYUGP is successful completion of Grade 12 or equivalent stage of education.
- 2nd year: The minimum entry requirement for the 2nd year FYUGP is a certificate obtained after the successful completion of 1 year (2 semesters) of the undergraduate programme. These students are to be admitted in the 2nd year within three years of obtaining the UG certificate from Gauhati University or any other University/institution recognized by Gauhati University.
- 3rd year: The minimum entry requirement for the 3rd year FYUGP is a diploma obtained after successful completion of 2 years (4 semesters) of the undergraduate program. These students are to be admitted to the 3rd year UG program within three years of obtaining the UG diploma certificate from Gauhati University or any other University/institution recognized by Gauhati University.
- 4th Year: The minimum entry requirement for the 4th year (Honours) FYUGP is a three-year Bachelor's Degree. The minimum entry requirement for the 4th year (Honours) UG programis within three years from obtaining a 3-year Bachelor's Degree certificate from Gauhati University or any other University/institution recognized by Gauhati University.
- The statutory reservation policy of the government shall be followed in case of the selection of eligible candidates for admission.
- Provided a student, who has passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) in Science/ Arts with mathematics/ statistics as one of the subjects of the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council, or an equivalent examination recognized as such by Gauhati University shall also be eligible for admission into the B.Com. Program.

### **CREDITS**

A course's credit usually corresponds to a specific amount of academic work. One credit, as defined by NEP 2020, is equal to thirty hours of academic work or learning hours, which includes studying, taking exams, attending lectures, taking part in debates, doing assignments, and working on projects.

As long as a student earns the necessary credit hours for each relevant course, they are qualified to take the end-of-semester exam. To make up for the shortage in credit hours, students must work with the instructor(s) in question and submit a certificate stating as much before the test. He or she lost a year as a result of not following through on this, and as a result, they will need to reapply for readmission in the same semester the following year. However, a first-semester student who lacks the required number of credit hours to sit for the end-semester exam will no longer be considered an official student of this college.

per 21 st edition of DDC. The Library is partially automated using the SOUL 2.0 (Software for

University Libraries) software developed by INFLIBNET Center, an autonomous body of UGC.

The library has three halls:

First/Front Hall: It has an area of 1160 sq. ft. consisting of a Property Shelf, Circulation Desk along with the OPAC, Newspaper Stand, and the Reading room with a seating capacity of 52 for students and 16 for teachers at a time.

Second hall: With an area of 1160sq. ft. It has Periodical stand for journals, magazines, and periodicals and a child corner was established to provide library services to the children of adapting villages of college and the students of the nearest schools or other institutions.

A separate e-resource center is present with 2PCs for accessing e-resources and other internet-based services. The Librarian's desk is present on the left side of this hall and the reference section is present beside the Librarian's desk.

Third hall: The hall has an area of 780 sq. ft. and consists of a stack area for HS, Graduation, and Bound Periodicals.
